All,

The following is what you can expect from SHV RAPCON during the Airshow activities. The air show events will begin Wednesday, April 29, 2015, with the arrival of Blue Angel #7. He will be providing media rides at 1200, 1330, and 1500 to the Anne MOA. The remainder of the Blue Angels will arrive on Thursday at approximately 1200L. Blue Angels 1 – 4 will be conducting circling maneuvers 1145 to 1245. Blue Angels 5 and 6 will be conducting circling maneuvers from 1245 – 1345. The Blue Angels practice show will be 1445 – 1500. Upon completion Fat Albert (C-130) will conduct circling maneuvers. The TFR times are attached to this memo.

**DOWNTOWN (DTN): DTN will be permitted to land from the North and depart to the North during the time the TFR is in effect – as long as there is not a show going on that will use the entire TFR airspace. All aircraft arriving and departing must be on a code. The majority of the performers do not use the entire TFR; however, the Blue Angels, B-52/B-1/B-2 flyby, Mig-17, A-26 Lady Liberty, and B-25 all require the entire 5 mile ring. DTN will NOT have automatics so we will need to cancel them each day before the TFR goes into effect. NO pattern work or practice approaches during the TFR at any time.**
